NOMINATION OF YOUTH ADVISORY DELEGATES(YAD)

1. The Nominating Committee shall place before the presbytery at its December meeting the names of one to be elected Youth Advisory Delegate and one as Alternate to the General Assembly meeting for the following year.
2. These nominees shall be persons who are a member of a church in Muskingum Valley Presbytery
 - a. Have not attended the General Assembly as a Youth Advisory Delegate in the last four years.
 - b. Are actively involved in the life of their church. Church camp and college experiences can be additional activities to be considered.
 - c. The application form, with Session endorsement, must be completed by the applicant and returned to the chair of the Nominating Committee of Presbytery.
3. Alternates will be selected as carefully as principals. Unless activated as alternates they may be given preference for the next General Assembly but must apply again.
